Meredith Hagner made her screen debut in the CBS daytime soap opera As the World Turns in 2008, as Liberty Ciccone. She was nominated an Daytime Emmy Award for Outstanding Younger Actress in a Drama Series in 2009. Hagner ended her two-year run as the character in March 2010.

Hagner starred in the FX short-leved 2011 drama series Lights Out. Hagner also appeared in a recurring role in the medical comedy Royal Pains on USA Network as Libby, and guest-starred on In Plain Sight, CSI: Miami, and The Following. In 2012, Hagner began starring as Amy Jordan in the TBS comedy series Men at Work.

George Travis Darold Milne XI is Norwegian, Scottish, Irish, English, and Czech Republic - In other words Canadian.

When he was 12 yrs old his mother and step-father moved him to a town called Lac La Biche, AB. During High School he participated in extracurricular activities such as Football, Basketball, Track & Field, X-C Running, and the Theatre program. In his last year at J.A.Williams H.S. the arts program director Joanne Metchooyeah suggested that Travis should apply to theatre school. He did so and was accepted. After three years of rigorous training at the RDC Theatre and Film program he finally got his first agent. Travis continued to work as a parttime actor, and full-time carpenter for three years while he rode out the tough

In 2008, he landed his first supporting lead role as a lawyer named 'Eric Baldwin' in the edgy TV Movie Confessions of a Go-Go Girl. a year later he played 'Bobby' in Reginald Harkema's film , Manson My Name is Evil - which premiered at the 2009 Toronto Film Festival.

Travis had applied to the power engineering program at his home town college, and was three weeks away from going back to trade school before he landed the series Rookie Blue. It had it's world premiere simultaneously in Canada and the U.S. in the summer of 2010, and has now gone on to make 74 episodes.

Travis still enjoys all aspects of architecture, design, and DIY home improvements. In his spare time you'll usually find him at a hardware store.

Anna Van Hooft is an actress who has appeared in a number of films and television productions. Most notably, she appeared in the 2006 remake of the horror movie The Wicker Man, which starred Nicolas Cage and Ellen Burstyn. Her other acting credits include roles in The Incredible Mrs. Ritchie, CSI, Trollz, Twelve Mile Road, Caitlin's Way, and John Tucker Must Die. She is slated to play Aura in the science fiction series Flash Gordon.

Johnson is also responsible for producing the international hit series, DR. QUINN, MEDICINE WOMAN for CBS PRODS/SULLIVAN COMPANY for over 5 seasons. During his 100-episode tenure, he also launched LIVE FROM THE RANCH with Orson Bean - a nationally syndicated talk show focusing on family values in America. He also developed and produced the original docu-drama COLD CASE for CBS network, which was the very first program to integrate television with the Internet.
