Synopsis

Landscape architect Susanna just found out her boyfriend isn't ready to settle down and now she's stranded with a flat tire and no jack. But lucky for her handsome Nate, complete with a British accent, pulls up. While he's never changed a tire, she has, and as they work together under the "Lover's Oak" she finds out he's in public relations in a country called Cambria. What Nate doesn't mention is he's actually Prince Nathaniel and about to be crowned King Nathaniel. Though there's a spark between them, he must find a Cambrian bride. Nevertheless, the two fall for each other and their intimacy is caught on film. His secret out, a sad prince must leave his sweet Susanna behind and head home to appease his mother. Determined to prove her son's "American" can't handle royal life, the Queen arranges for her to apprentice with a landscape architect in Cambria but her plan backfires when the two grow even closer. MEGAN PARK



A Canadian born actress, Megan Park is known for her critically acclaimed roles in numerous hit television series and feature films including Aaron Sorkin's "The Newsroom," "Central Intelligence," with Kevin Hart and Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson, and "Charlie Bartlett," with Robert Downey Jr. She was awarded TIFF's "Rising Star" for her role in What If, alongside Daniel Radcliff and Zoe Kazan, but is best known for her starring role on six seasons of the ABC Family hit show "The Secret Life of the American Teenager," for which she won a People's Choice Award and Teen Choice Award.

Park's directorial debut was in 2016 when she wrote and directed the short film, Lucy in My Eyes, which premiered at the 2017 Austin Film Festival and won the Grand Jury Prize for Best Short. Recently writing a pilot, which CBS studios bought, Park and is now writing a feature film for New Line-Warner Bros. with Shailene Woodley attached as the star. Park also recently co-wrote and co-directed a web series titled, "We're Adults Now," with Canadian writer Katie Boland.

An avid director of several music videos, which have grossed more than fifty million views, Park has worked with artists such as Mike Posner, Blackbear, Gucci Mane and Billie Eilish. As an actress, she has two feature films and several projects in production slated for a 2018 release, and she has numerous other writing and directing projects in development.

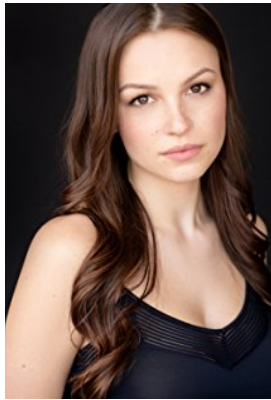
JONATHAN KELTZ

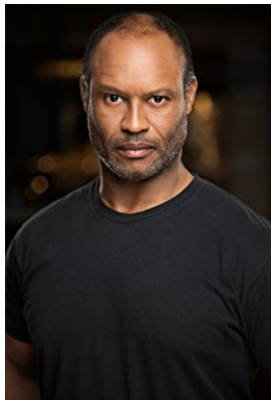

He was also moved to his career by Kenneth Branagh's performance in Hamlet, as well as by a Master Class with Alan Arkin. He got his start in Toronto in a recurring role on "Degrassi: The Next Generation," and later appeared opposite Heather Graham in Cake, followed by the role of Chris Cooper's son in Breach for Universal. His additional notable credits include playing Ari Gold's assistant, Jake Steinberg, on HBO's "Entourage" and co-starring roles in Disney's Prom as well as 21 & Over opposite Miles Teller. Keltz's other television credits include a recurring role on the final season of "Necessary Roughness" for USA and guest star roles on "Man Seeking Woman," "Flashpoint," "Leverage" and "Breakout Kings."
