She hit the ground running, with her first role being a supporting lead in Spare Parts (RLJE Films, Amazon Prime) and has continued on an upward trajectory.

Apart from acting, Kohut is an avid horseback rider, and extreme sports enthusiast with a passion for dirt biking, wake boarding, skiing and Muay Thai. Ontario based actor, Ryan Bannon, is a classically trained guitarist and has been studying acting using the Meisner technique for several years. In addition to commercial and theatrical appearances, Ryan has had roles in several TV series, shorts and in the upcoming film Wildfire.
